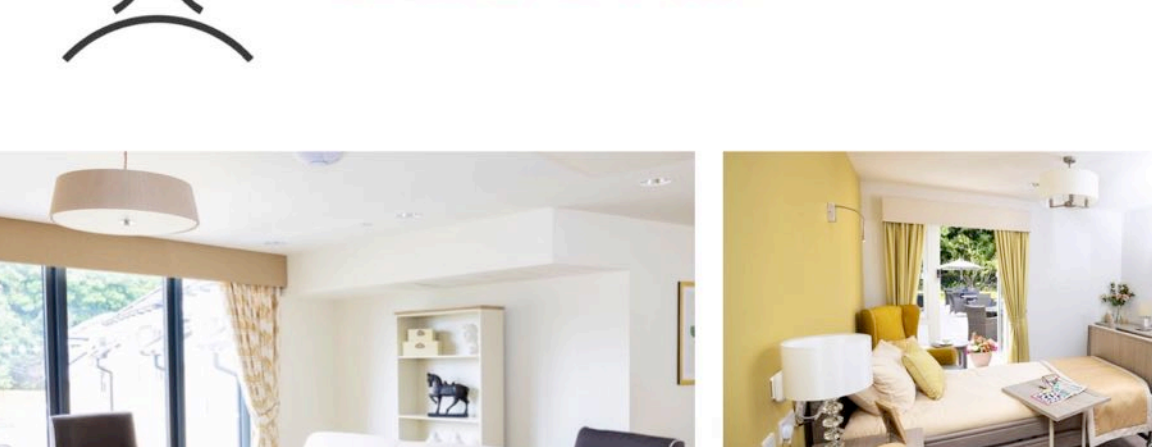

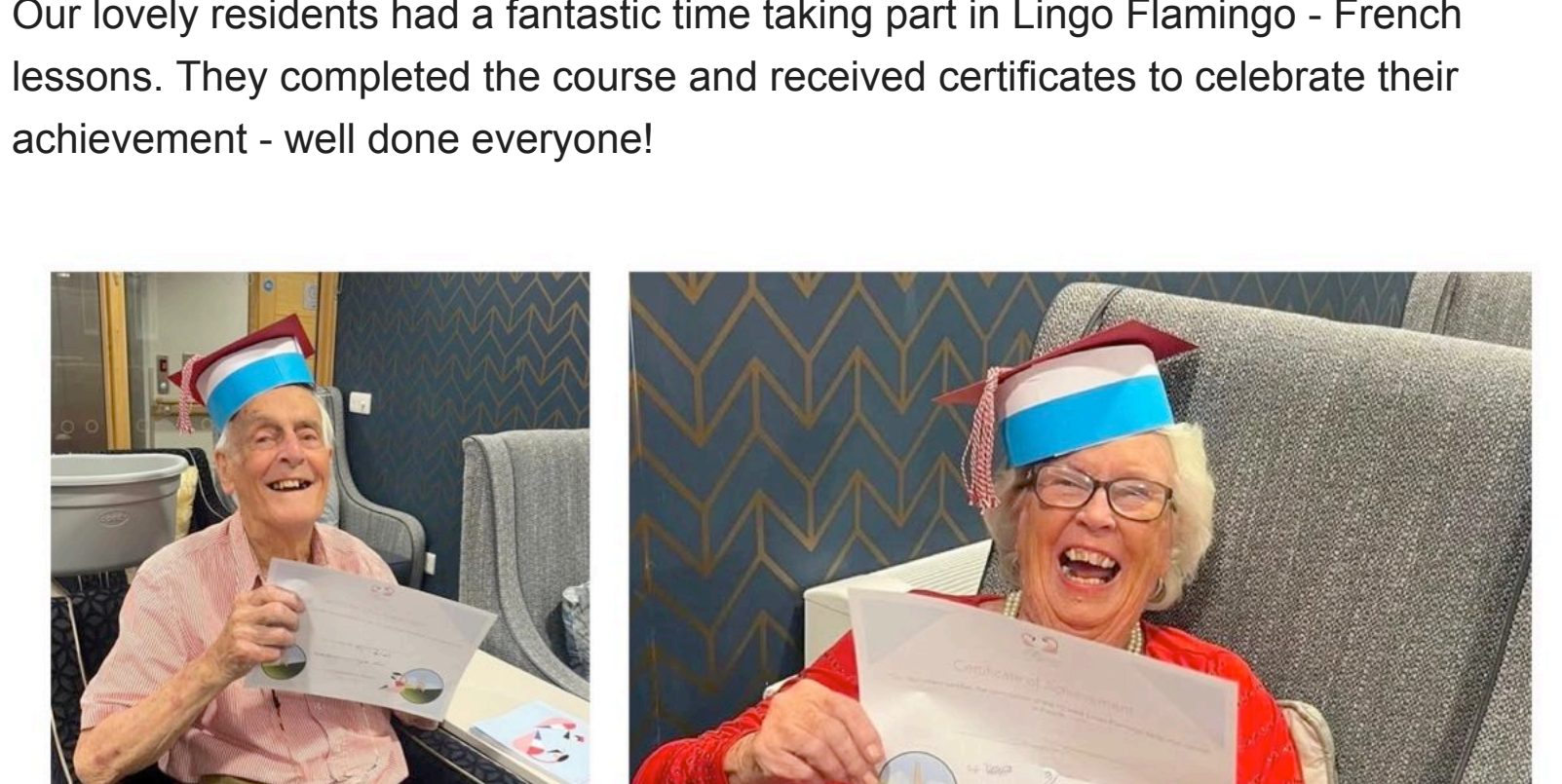

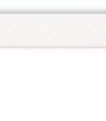


Lingo Flamingo

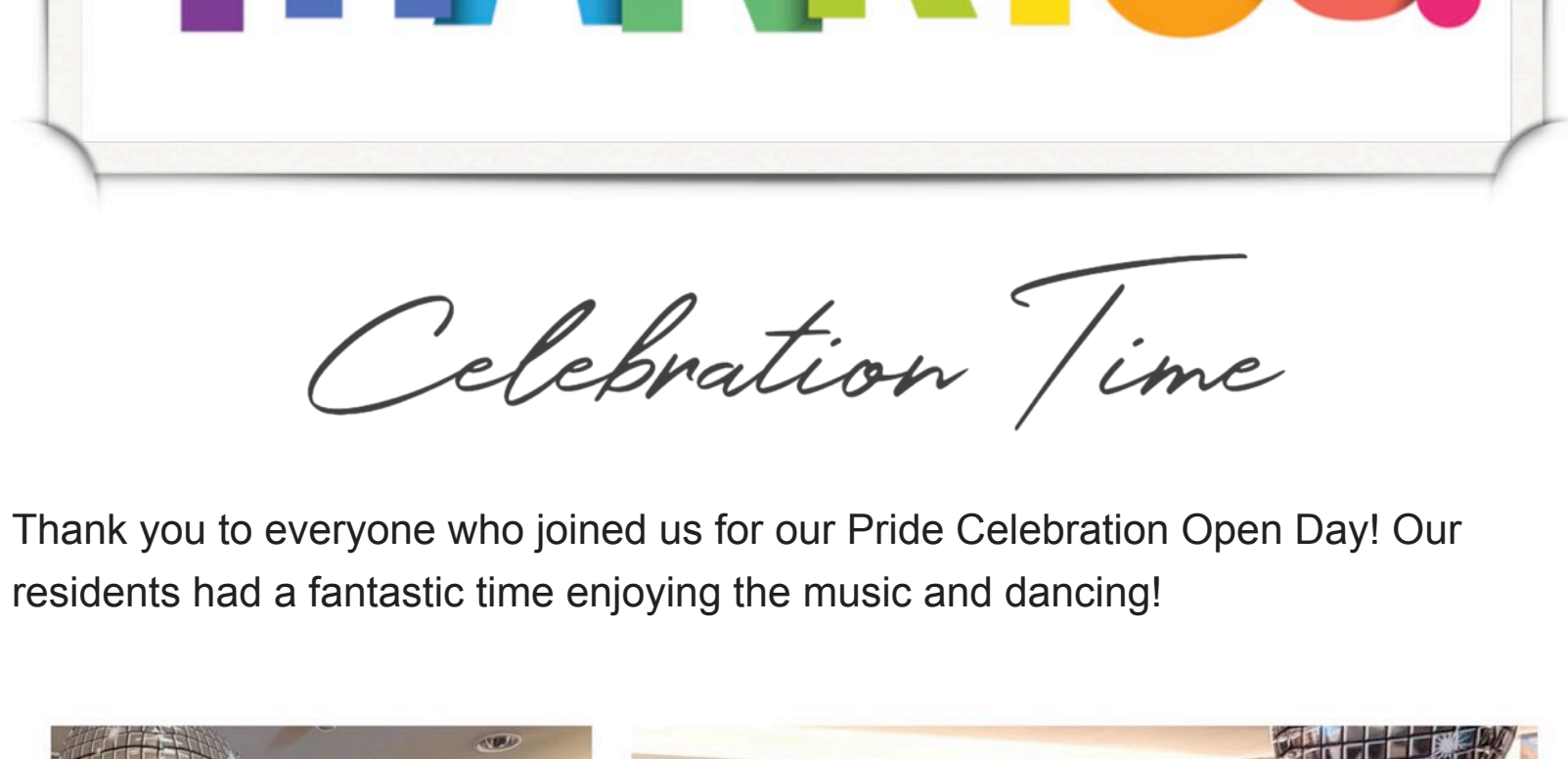


Well Done

Our lovely residents had a fantastic time taking part in Lingo Flamingo - French lessons. They completed the course and received certificates to celebrate their achievement - well done everyone!

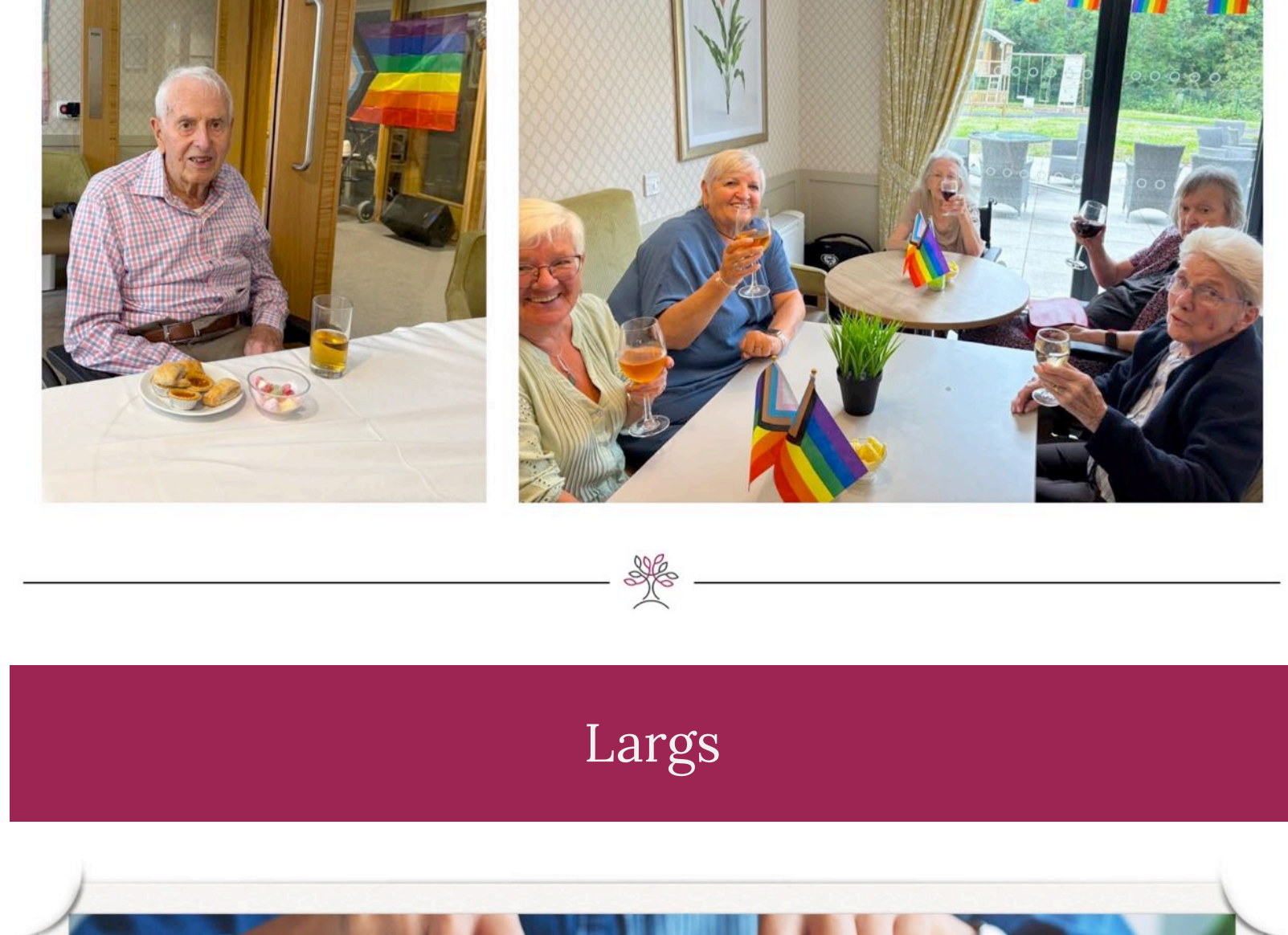

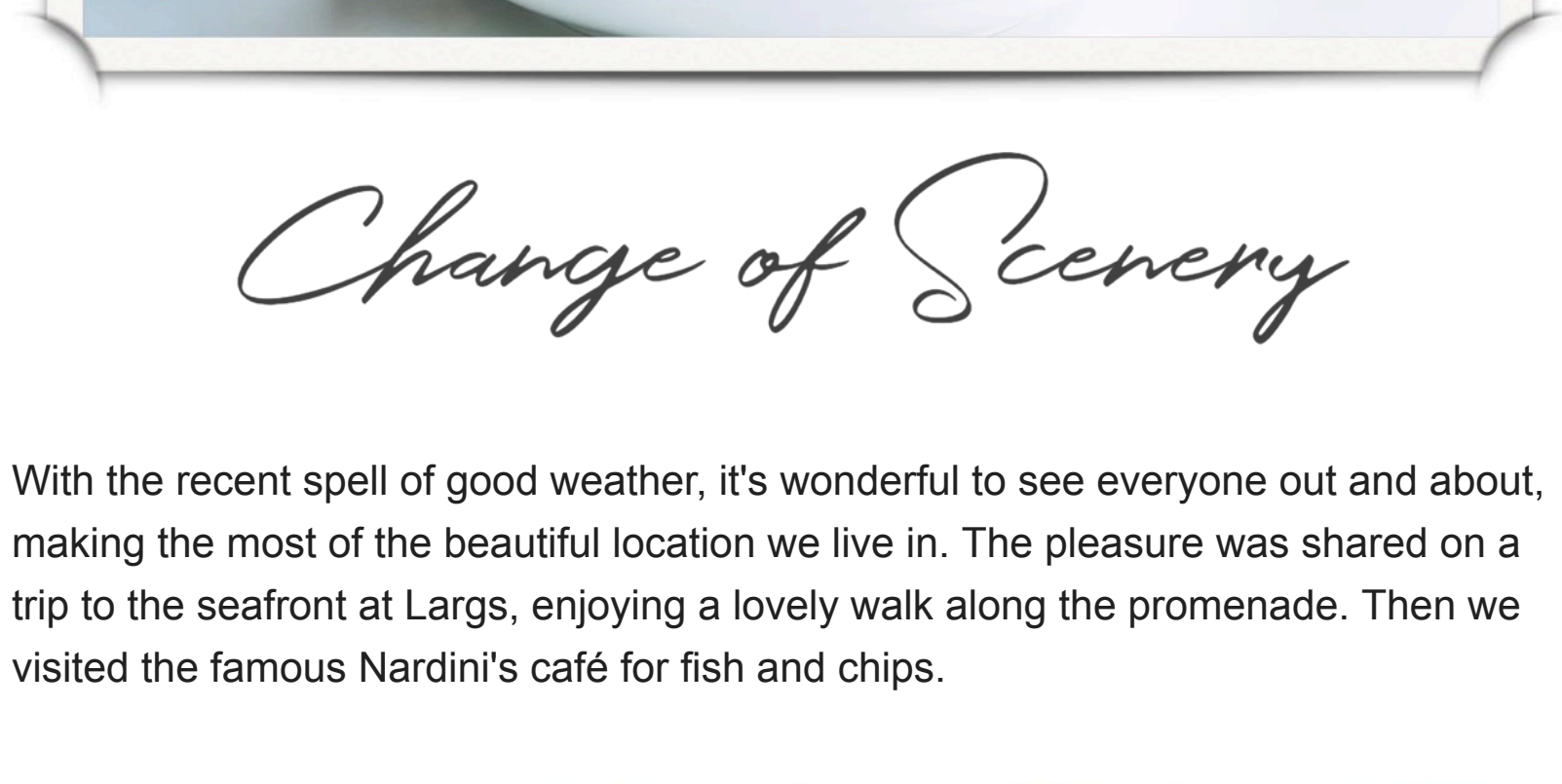


Celebration Time

Thank you to everyone who joined us for our Pride Celebration Open Day! Our residents had a fantastic time enjoying the music and dancing!

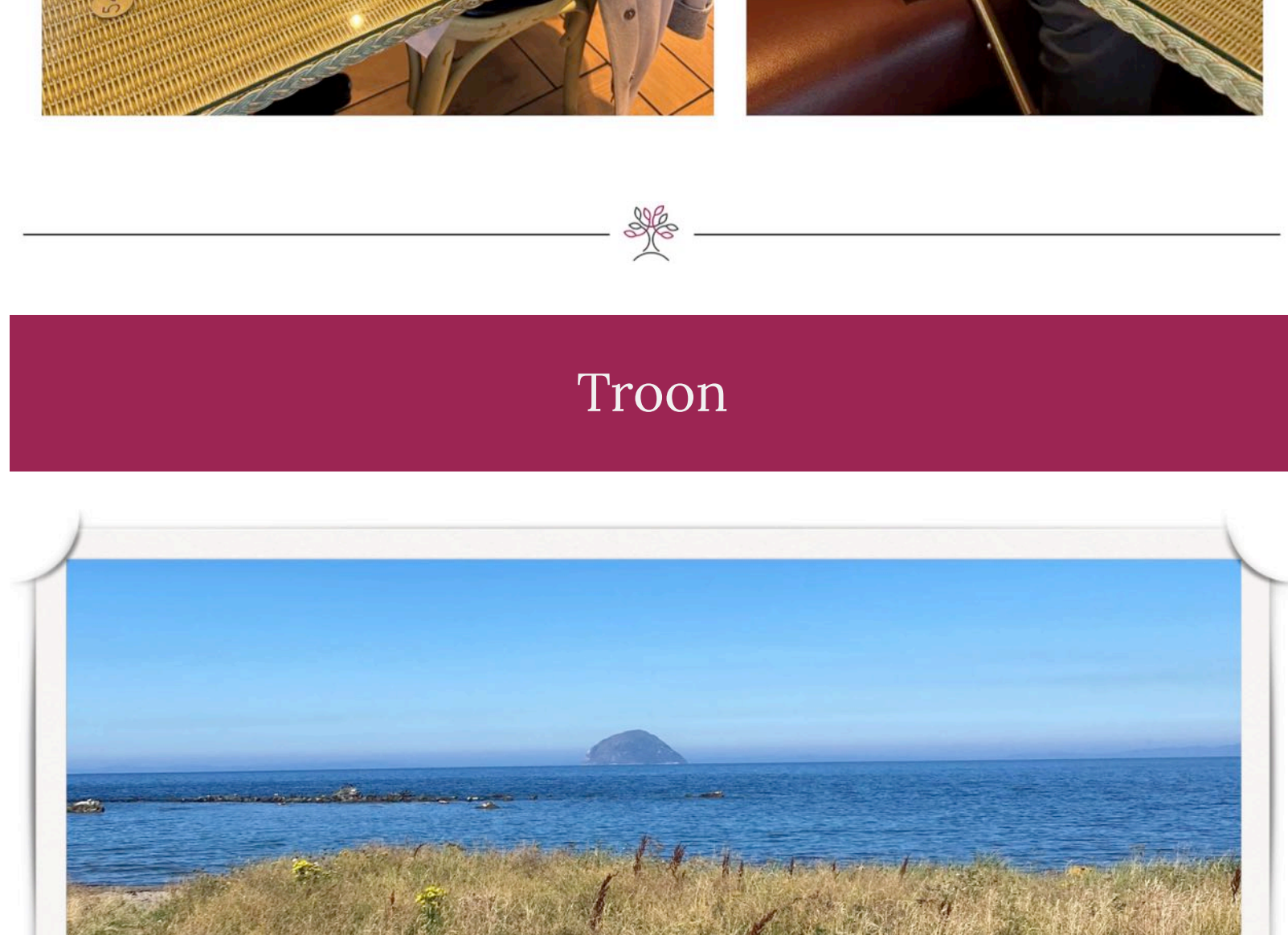

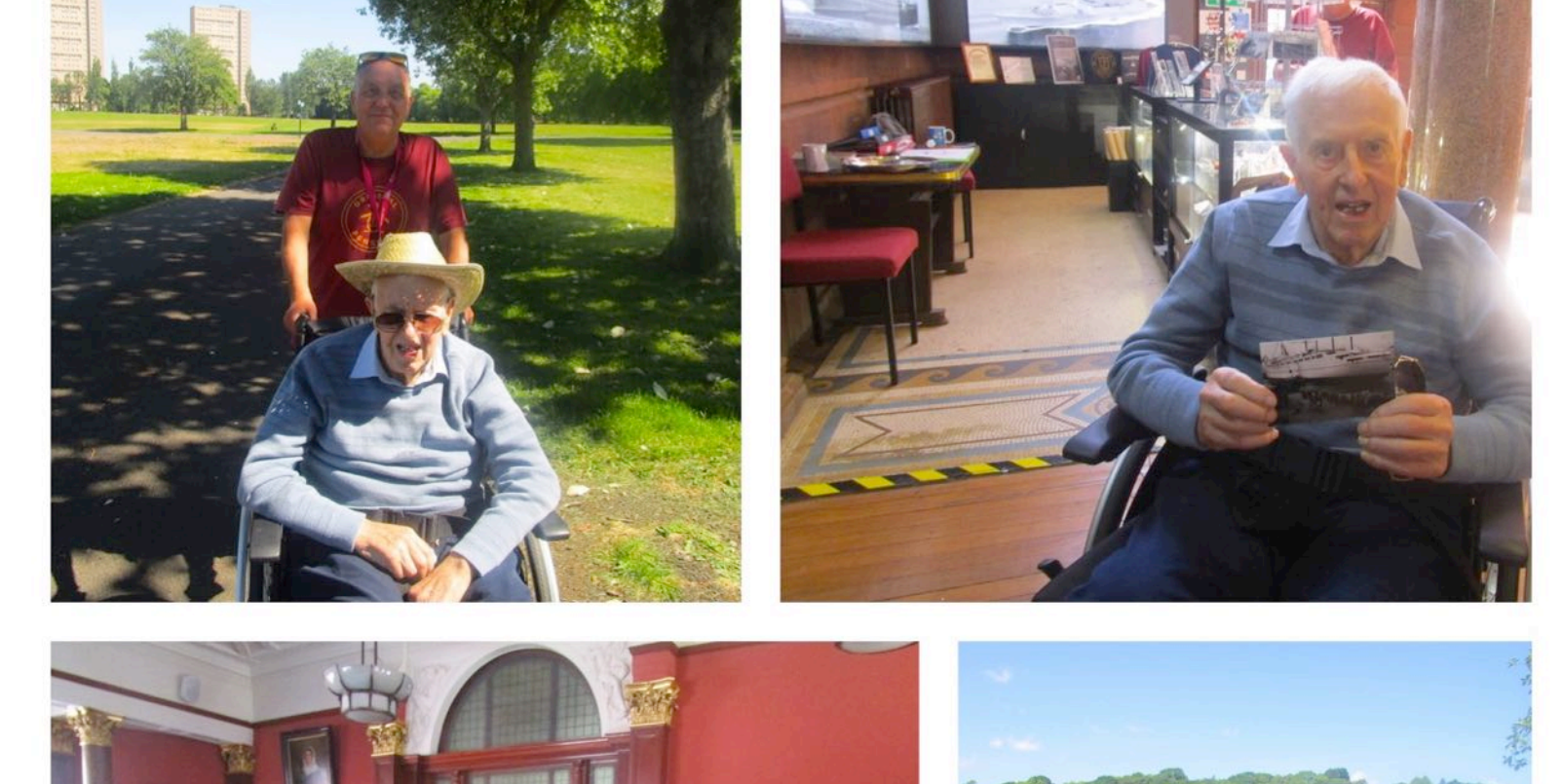


Fresh Air & Sunshine

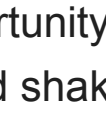


Fairfield Heritage

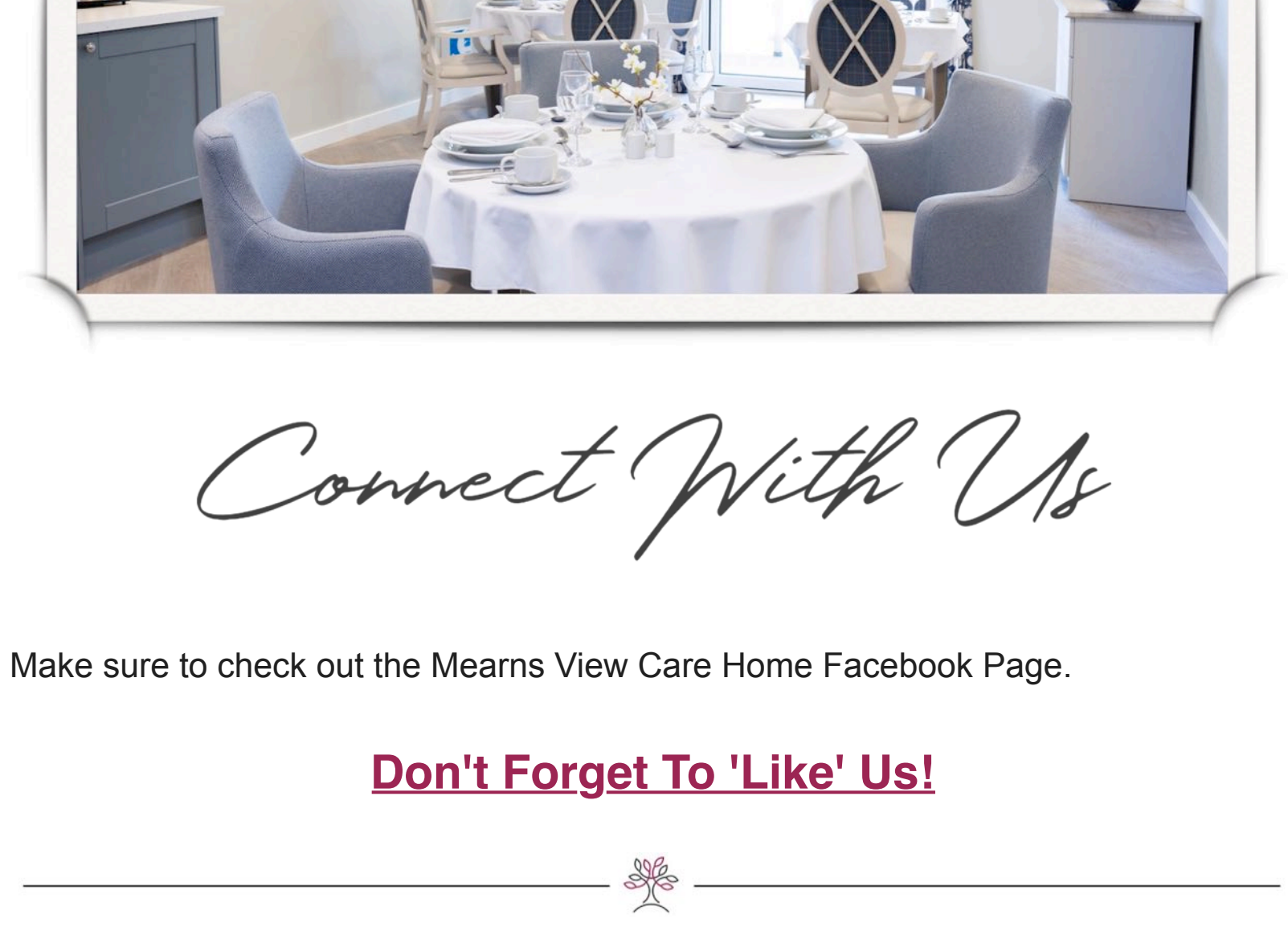


Jack the Therapy Dog

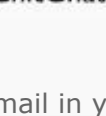

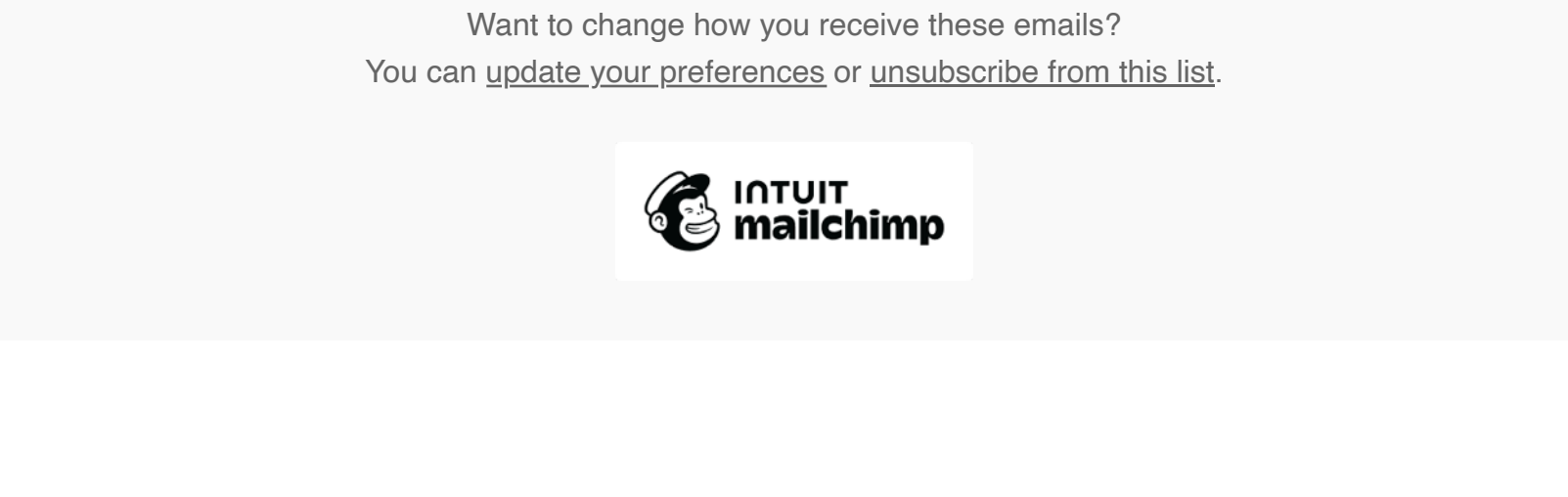
